According to Health Canada's website, the Ministry of Health is in frequent contact with manufacturers and is monitoring the situation closely. We understand that Health Canada anticipates a return to full production sometime in 2023, however parents deserve to know exactly when they can expect to see shelves stocked with infant formula.

That is why we are requesting an update on when exactly in 2023 parents will see stocked shelves, and your government's plan to ensure that this never happens again.
